This Ordinance proposes to fix the salaries for the elected officers of the City of Auburn for the year 2012. The salaries for 2012 shall be: 1) \$1,948.12 Biweekly for the Mayor; 2) \$1,881.52 Biweekly for the Clerk-Treasurer; 3) \$167.32 Biweekly for the Members of the Council; 4) \$50.00 per meeting per diem for the Member of the Council who serves on the Plan Commission and \$20.00 per meeting per diem for the Member of the Council who serves on the Plan Commission Sub-Committee.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN,
INDIANA, THAT:**

Section 1.

Salaries for the elective officials of the City of Auburn, Indiana, for the year 2012 are hereby fixed in the following amounts:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Elective Officials shall be paid biweekly beginning with the pay period payable January 1, 2012.


Section 3.


