## AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE 2018-03 RE-ESTABLISHING THE CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND TAX RATE AT \$0.05 PER \$100 OF ASSESSED VALUATION

Fund tax rate at \$0.05 per \$100 of assessed valuation for all uses as set out in

welfare, or safety in an emergency situation which demand immediate action.

### ORDINANCE 2018-07

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**WHEREAS**, on April 19, 1994 the Common Council of the City of Auburn Established, by Ordinance 94-10, A Cumulative Capital Development Fund; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Auburn, DeKalb County, Indiana, finds that such a fund is necessary and prudent for the financial well being of the municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the tax rate and levy have been adjusted through the years and currently is \$0.0448 per \$100 of assessed valuation with the allowable rate being \$0.05 per \$100 of assessed valuation; and,

**WHEREAS**, The City of Auburn Common Council desires to re-establish the rate to \$0.05 per \$100 of assessed valuation;

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA:

#### Section I.

The City of Auburn Common Council will adhere to the provisions of IC 36-9-15.5. The Cumulative Capital Development Fund will not exceed \$0.05 per \$100 of assessed valuation. Said tax rate will be levied beginning with taxes for 2018 payable 2019 and thereafter continuing until reduced or rescinded.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that proofs of publication of the public hearing held on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2018 and a certified copy of this ordinance shall be submitted to the Department of Local Government Finance of the State of Indiana as provided by law. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in DeKalb County, Indiana subject to approval by the Department of Local Government Finance.
