**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN,
INDIANA, THAT:**

Section 1.

Salaries for the elective officials of the City of Auburn for the year 2023 are hereby fixed
in the following amounts:

MAYOR:

TOTAL: \$3,206.98 Bi-weekly

CLERK-TREASURER:

TOTAL: \$3,179.84 Bi-weekly

COUNCIL MEMBERS:

TOTAL: \$228.17 Bi-weekly

Section 2.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Elective Official shall be paid biweekly beginning
with the first pay period in January 2023.

Section 3.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that salaries shall be paid with Enterprise funds, Fire
Territory Operating fund and, where applicable, Municipal funds.

Section 4.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City of Auburn shall pay for each eligible Elective Officials contribution to Public Employees Retirement Fund that is required by Indiana State statute.

Section 5.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and signing by the Mayor.


