**A GENERAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 76 OF THE CODE OF

**SUMMARY**

The following ordinance amends Schedule III. Limited Parking Time of the Code of the Municipal City of Auburn, Indiana, to reflect a 2-hour parking restriction on both sides of Fifth Street between Main Street and Cedar Street.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05**

**A GENERAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 76 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 76 of the Code of Municipal City of Auburn, Indiana provides the Parking Schedules for city streets within the City of Auburn, Indiana; and

**WHEREAS**, Schedule III of Chapter 76 of the Code of Municipal City of Auburn, Indiana provides limitations on parking times on identified City Streets when signs are erected providing notice of said parking time limitations; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend Schedule III of Chapter 76 of the Code of Municipal City of Auburn, Indiana to reflect the need to provide limitations on parking times along Fifth Street, between Main Street and Cedar Street, due to the presence of additional retail businesses along Fifth Street and the desire to reasonably make available on-street parking for patrons of the businesses.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA:**

**Section I:**

Schedule III of Chapter 76 of the Code of Municipal City of Auburn, Indiana shall be amended to add the following street segment:

**SCHEDULE III. LIMITED PARKING TIME**

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle longer than the time specified during the times and days specified, if any, within the district or upon any of the streets described as follows:

Street	Side	Location	Time Limit	When Restricted
5 <sup>th</sup> St.	Both	Main St. to Cedar St.	2 hours	8am-5pm

**Section II:**

The City of Auburn shall take steps to memorialize said amended schedule in Chapter 76 of the Code of Municipal City of Auburn, Indiana and shall further erect and maintain appropriate signage on said street. Any act of the City to establish appropriate signage shall be incorporated into Chapter 76 herein by reference and shall be considered an enforceable provision of the Auburn City Code.

**Section III:**


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage by the Auburn Common Council, and the notice of this amendment by publishing the summary of this Ordinance in an appropriate newspaper in accordance with Indiana Code and by keeping a paper pamphlet of this Ordinance and Auburn City Traffic Code for availability to the public at City Hall in accordance with Indiana Code located at 210 E. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, Auburn, Indiana during regularly posted business hours. Further the provisions set forth

herein shall be incorporated into the City Code which is maintained at the City of Auburn web site located at [www.ci.auburn.in.us](http://www.ci.auburn.in.us) and available for public inspection and review.





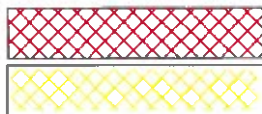
