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**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF AUBURN AUTHORIZING THE

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Auburn, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits, and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons, and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities, and economic needs of its low- and moderate-income residents.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Auburn, Indiana that:

1. The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit a proposal and application for grant funding on behalf of the Auburn Automotive Heritage, Inc. d/b/a Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum (ACDAM) (Sub-Recipient) to complete the ACDAM's Showroom Facade Preservation Project, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.


2. The City of Auburn, Indiana (Applicant), hereby commits the requisite local funds will be provided by the Auburn Automotive Heritage, Inc. d/b/a ACDAM (Sub-Recipient), per an agreement, in the amount of eight hundred fifty thousand (\$850,000.00) in the form of Auburn Automotive Heritage, Inc. d/b/a ACDAM, Restricted Capital Campaign Account Funds, as matching funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CDBG/PFP funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.


