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**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 50, SEWER ORDINANCE
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AUBURN**

WHEREAS, the Auburn Common Council has determined it is in the best interests of the citizens of Auburn, Indiana to amend Chapter 50: Sewer Ordinance of the City of Auburn Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 50: Sewer Ordinance establishes the requirements for connection to the City of Auburn Sanitary Sewer System; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 50: Sewer Ordinance allows properties not within the corporate limits of the City of Auburn to connect to the City Sanitary Sewer system subject to certain conditions.

SECTION 1. That Chapter 50: Sewer Ordinance for the City of Auburn, Indiana is hereby amended as provided in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

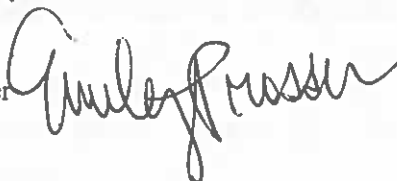


EXHIBIT "A"

50.144 EXTENSIONS OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS

If a location is outside the City corporate limits but within four (4) miles of such limits and within the facility planning area of the City's POTW, then the City may extend wastewater service to any such location, providing for payment of capital cost expenditures of any such extension through the applicable Barrett Law procedures, contract with the property owners or by contract with those directly benefited by such extension. Any such contract for extension of services shall be entered into between the City by its Board of Public Works and the property owner upon such terms and conditions as may be deemed necessary by such Board and shall include an agreement by the property owner to waive any and all right to challenge any future attempted annexation of the subject property by the City, and shall provide for the payment of sewer user, connection, and inspection fees in accordance with Article X. The requester of sanitary sewer services shall be required to submit an irrevocable petition for voluntary annexation of the property being served if said property is contiguous to the current corporate boundary limits of the City of Auburn. If said property does not comply with the contiguous boundary required for voluntary annexation, the requester of sanitary sewer services shall be required to sign an agreement waiving any remonstrance of future annexation of the property served by the sanitary sewer extension and agree to submit a petition for voluntary annexation if contiguity requirements are met at a future date. Said agreement shall become a part and condition of any conveyance of real property which is the subject of the sanitary sewer extension.
