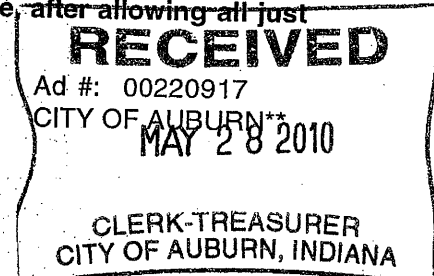

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
On or about July 2, 2010, City of Auburn intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for a grant from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs' CDBG Disaster Recovery Appropriation. This program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. These funds are to be used for job creation assistance. The total amount of Disaster Recovery funds to be requested is \$1,000,000. The amount of Disaster Recovery funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low- and

moderate-income persons is \$528,800 (52.88%). The Applicant also proposes to expend an estimated \$980,000 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: Tax Increment Financing (TIF) funds \$980,000.
City of Auburn will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 1, 2010, at 6:00PM, in City Council Chambers in City Hall at 210 E. Ninth Street, Auburn, IN to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG Disaster Recovery project.
