RESOLUTION NO. 03-2010

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Auburn recognizes the need to stimulate and to maintain a sound economy within its core corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding associated with the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2008 Public Law 110-252, approved June 30, 2008, and Public Law 110-329, approved September 30, 2008, for the disaster relief of unmet needs resulting from tornadoes and flooding in the state, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low- and moderate-income residents; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA:

Section 1.

The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the North Side Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.


Section 2.

The City of Auburn, Indiana hereby commits local funds in the amount of nine hundred and eighty thousand dollars and zero cents (\$980,000.00), in the form of Tax Increment Financing (TIF) funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of Disaster CDBG funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.




