AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF AN CITY STREET LOCATED IN THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City of Auburn, Indiana to vacate a portion of Walnut Street between Van Buren Street and Wayne Street, which is approximately 66 feet wide by 128.25 feet long and between Lot Sixty and Block One of the Ensley's Second Addition both owned by the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing of the City of Auburn Common Council was held on the 5th day of April, 2011 at 6:00 P.M. at the Auburn Common Council Chambers regarding the petition for vacation, and

WHEREAS, a second reading of the Ordinance was held on April 5, 2011, and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and opportunity for public notice and comment; and

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA THAT:

Section 1.

The portion of the platted street (right-of-way), which is approximately 66 feet wide and 128.25 feet long between Van Buren and Wayne Streets and adjacent to Block One to the north and lot 60 to the south is hereby vacated. One-half of said right-of-way shall be granted/conveyed to Block One and one-half of the said right-of-way shall be granted/conveyed to the lot numbered 60. Said lots are located within the Ensley's Second addition to the City of Auburn, Indiana recorded at the office of the DeKalb County Recorder. See Exhibit "A", consisting of two (2) pages, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof further setting forth the area being vacated.

Section 2.

The Municipal City of Auburn shall retain an easement across the vacated right-ofway/street for the purpose of providing, maintaining, and expanding utilities in the future. The Municipal City of Auburn shall have the right to maintain, expand, and repair utilities within said right-of-way.

Section 3.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance be in full force and effect from and after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in DeKalb County, Indiana.


