ORDINANCE NO. 2021-05

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE ARP CORONAVIRUS
LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY GRANT FUND (FUND #176)**

SUMMARY

This Ordinance calls for the Common Council of The City of Auburn, Indiana to establish the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Grant Fund (Fund #176) pursuant to IC 5-11. The sources of funding for the newly established fund will include monies allocated to the City from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA). The monies within this fund shall be used for eligible purposes of the ARPA. Funds receipted into this Fund will require an additional appropriation approved by Common Council. The fiscal officer will review the requested use of monies along with the City attorney and financial advisor for compliance with ARPA requirements. The fiscal officer will also maintain detailed accounting records of the fund to provide for future audits of the ARP fund.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN,
INDIANA:**

Section I:

The Common Council of the City of Auburn, DeKalb County, Indiana, recognizes that a need now exists for the establishment of the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Grant Fund (Fund #176) pursuant to Indiana Code 5-11.

Section II:

The sources of funding for the newly established fund will include monies allocated to the City from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA). The monies within this fund shall be used for eligible purposes of the ARPA.

Section III:

Funds receipted into this Fund will require an additional appropriation (Common Council approval) and the fiscal officer will review the requested use of monies along with the City attorney and financial advisor for compliance with ARPA requirements. The fiscal officer will also maintain detailed accounting records of the fund to provide for future audits of the ARP fund.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common council and signing by the Mayor.
