(Contractor) for the 19<sup>th</sup> Street (Van Buren Street to Jackson Street) Sanitary Sewer Improvements project involving excavation and replacement of various sizes of sewer pipe, manholes, trench special back-fill, and temporary pavement restoration, all in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the City of Auburn Engineering Department, and to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, tools, transportation, etc. necessary for the contract.

The Contract Price of your contract is Forty-One Thousand, Five Hundred Fifty Dollars and No Cents (\$41,550.00)


In accordance with the Quote documents, the work will have an allowable commencing date of March 14, 2022 and achieve final completion and be ready for final payment on or before June 3, 2022. Once construction starts, Contractor shall maintain a continuous construction schedule until completed. All material and workmanship shall be guaranteed to the City of Auburn for three (3) years by Contractor providing a Maintenance Bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the final construction contract price. Maintenance Bond shall be submitted with the final pay application.

Contractor shall deliver to the Owner a certificate of insurance prior to any work commencing.
