ORDINANCE NO. 2023-22 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2018-24, as amended, adopted an Official Zoning Map for the City of Auburn, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code section §36-7-4-600 et. seq provides for amendments to the zoning map of a municipality by ordinance of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, this amendment to the Zoning Map assigns a zoning district that will accommodate single-family residential dwelling units; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn Plan Commission at its October 10, 2023 meeting held a legally advertised Public Hearing regarding a request to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Auburn, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn Plan Commission, on October 10, 2023, heard input from the public and ultimately forwarded a *favorable recommendation* to the Auburn Common Council, with 9 votes in favor of the favorable recommendation and 0 votes against the favorable recommendation concerning the rezoning of said real estate.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA, THAT:

The Zoning Map of the City of Auburn shall be amended in the following manner:

That 711 Hazel Street, as illustrated in Exhibit A and legally described in Exhibit B, be reclassified from the 12 (Heavy Industrial District) to the R2 (Medium Density Single-Family Residential District).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance be in full force and effect after its passage by the Common Council and after the occurrence of all other actions required by law.

Legal Description

A part of the South One-half (1/2) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Union Civil Township, DeKalb County, Indiana and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot Numbered 22 in W.O.
