- 1. The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to complete the Memorial Park Improvements Project, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. The City of Auburn, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of One Million, One Hundred Seven Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars (\$1,107,627.00) in the form of Auburn ARPA Funds (\$940,000.00), Park & Recreation Sale of Property Account (\$119,405) and HELP Grant Fund Misc Revenue Account (\$48,222), as matching funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CDBG-CV funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
