ORDINANCE NO. 2024-18 AN ORDINANCE VACATING RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA

WHEREAS, a petition to vacate certain public right-of-way has been filed by Lakewood Park Baptist Church, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn desires to vacate certain right-of-way more particularly described as follows:

The ten-foot (10') north-south alley right-of-way located adjacent to Lot Twenty-One (21) through Lot Twenty-Six (26) in Block 7 in Forest Park Addition to the City of Auburn, Indiana; and the sixteen-foot (16') north-south alley located adjacent to Lot Twenty (20) and Lot Twenty-One (21) in Block 7 in Forest Park Addition to the City of Auburn, Indiana.

WHEREAS, said portion of right-of-way is unimproved regarding pavement infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on August 20, 2024 at 6:00 PM by the City of Auburn Common Council in the Norman E. Yoder Council Chambers regarding the petition for the right-of-way vacation request; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has provided notice, pursuant to Indiana Code §36-7-3-12(c) and 5-3-1 et. seq. that it desires to vacate certain public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, a second reading of the Ordinance will be held on September 3, 2024, and

WHEREAS, due consideration and opportunity has been given for public notice and comment.

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA THAT:

Section 1.

The right-of-way to be vacated is illustrated in Exhibit A, consisting of one (1) page, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof further setting forth the area being vacated.

Section 2.

The remaining portions of the platted ten-foot (10') alley to the north of Lot 26 and the remaining portions of the platted sixteen-foot (16') alley to the south of Lot 20 shall remain as originally platted.


Once this document is executed and recorded, the east one-half of the vacated right-of-way shall be conveyed to Lakewood Park Baptist Church, Inc. as the owner of the adjacent Lots 20 through 26 in Block 7 in Forest Park Addition to the City of Auburn, Indiana; and the west one-half of the vacated right-of-way shall be conveyed to the Auburn Port Authority as the owner of the adjacent property (former railroad right-of-way) to the west of the vacated alley right-of-way.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after publication of the summary of this Ordinance in a newspaper of general circulation in DeKalb County, Indiana.
