**ORDINANCE NO. 2026-11**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF AUBURN UNSAFE BUILDING FUND**

**SECTION 1.** That the Common Council of the City of Auburn, Indiana (“City”) desires to establish an Unsafe Building Fund pursuant to I.C. 36-7-9-14.

**WHEREAS,** a separate fund is necessary to properly account for the receipts and disbursements of monies received from any source.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Common Council of the City of Auburn, Indiana, as follows:

1. The City hereby creates and establishes a fund known as the “Unsafe Building Fund” to receive and disburse funds as they are received.
2. The primary purpose of the fund is to establish an account for the deposit of monies to render unsafe buildings safe. The monies for this fund may be received from any source, including appropriations by local, state, or federal governments, and donations. In addition, all monies required by I.C. 36-7-9-14, or by any other law of the State of Indiana, to be deposited in this fund, shall be deposited in this fund.
3. The Unsafe Building Fund shall be used to carry out the purposes of I.C. 36-7-9, et seq.
4. The Clerk-Treasurer of the City shall be responsible for the deposits and disbursements of the fund and shall keep records as to the disbursements, receipts, and current balance in such fund at all times.
5. In accordance with I.C. 36-7-9-14, any balance remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall be carried over in the fund for the following fiscal year and shall not revert to the general fund.
6. The fund shall be perpetual unless or until terminated or amended by the Common Council of the City; which shall only occur upon a change to the laws of the State of Indiana. Upon termination of the fund, the balance thereof shall revert to the General Fund.


**SECTION 2.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.




