RESOLUTION NO. 01-2010

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Auburn, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate and to maintain a sound economy with its core corporate limits: and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low – and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low- and moderate-income residents; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA:

Section 1.

The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the Downtown Revitalization Plan and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 2.

The City of Auburn, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of not less than five thousand six hundred dollars and zero cents (\$5,600.00) in the form of approximately \$3,000.00 to \$5,000.00 from the Building, Planning and Development Department's budget for professional services and the remainder from the general fund, professional services funds and/or local donations, as matching funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CDBG funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
