# AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO THE RAINY DAY FUND

### **SUMMARY**

Indiana Code 36-1-8-5.1 authorizes political subdivisions to receive transfers of unused and unencumbered monies to the Rainy Day Fund whenever the purposes of certain tax levies have been fulfilled and an unused and unencumbered balance remains.

This Ordinance is for the transfer of funds to the Rainy Day Fund as follows:

- 1. General Fund \$100,000.00 from Municipal General Professional Services.
- 2. General Fund \$1,000.00 from Engineering Operating Supplies
- 3. General Fund \$500.00 from Building, Planning and Development Operating Supplies.
- 4. General Fund \$500.00 from Information Systems Operating Supplies
- 5. General Fund \$16,000.00 from Police Department Operating Supplies
- 6. Street Department \$20,000 from MVH Operating Supplies
- 7. Park & Recreation Department \$5,000.00 from Park & Recreation Department
