## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Auburn recognizes the need to improve the areas adjacent the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum ("ACDAM") property to increase public awareness of the museums location and support the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum's need for additional common spaces and parking facilities; and

### Section 1.

The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the City of Auburn's Transportation Enhancement (TE) Application to the Indiana Department of Transportation for the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum Improvement Project and to coordinate with the ACDAM in the execution and administration of a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Department of Transportation.

#### Section 2.

The City of Auburn, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds up to two hundred fourteen thousand dollars (\$214,000) as matching funds for said program; such commitment to be contingent upon:

- 2. The receipt of TE funding from the Indiana Department of Transportation.
