This ordinance appropriates certain monies from the tax proceeds received from the Economic Development Income Tax Revenue on the cost of improvements to Auburn Essential Services ("AES") and the repayment of an interim borrowing for "AES" capital costs ("Project") and the incidental expenses in connection therewith, and on account of the issuance of the Economic Development Income Tax Revenue Bonds of 2011 ("Bonds").

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURN
APPROPRIATING THE PROCEEDS OF THE ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT INCOME TAX REVENUE BONDS OF
2011**

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Auburn, Indiana ("Issuer") has determined to issue bonds to provide for the cost of improvements to Auburn Essential Services ("AES") and the repayment of an interim borrowing for AES capital costs ("Project") and the incidental expenses in connection therewith, and on account of the issuance of the Economic Development Income Tax Revenue Bonds of 2011 ("Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, a notice of a public hearing on the appropriation of the proceeds of the Bonds in an amount not to exceed Three Million Four Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$3,425,000) to be issued for the purpose of procuring funds to be applied on the cost of the Project and the incidental expenses to be incurred in connection therewith and with the issuance and sale of the Bonds was properly published in *The Star* and the proof of publication was presented to the Common Council and placed in the City's records;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. An appropriation in an amount not to exceed Three Million Four Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$3,425,000) is hereby made to be applied on the costs of the Project and the incidental expenses incurred in connection therewith and on account of the issuance of Bonds therefor, and that the funds to meet said appropriation be provided out of the proceeds of the Bonds in an amount not to exceed Three Million Four Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$3,425,000) heretofore authorized; that said appropriation be in addition to all other appropriations provided for in the existing budget and tax levy for the current year.

Section 2. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to report and certify the additional appropriation to the Department of Local Government Finance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and appropriate publication in accordance with Indiana Code.

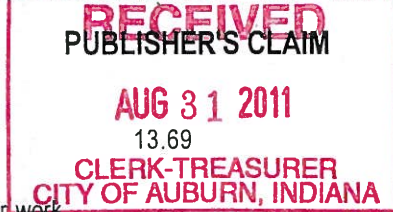
